**Ho Chi Minh City Tour**

Pick up by your guide and driver for this half-day tour will be at your hotel at around either 8am or 1.30pm depending on your preference and the first stop is at the Reunification Hall to visit the residence of the President Ngo Dinh Diem of the former South Vietnam until 1975 (1960s - Apr 1975s).

Here you will have the opportunity to view formal meeting rooms, private bedrooms and war situation rooms 10 meter beneath earth's level. This address today still holds many important functions in HCMC. You will learn important historical facts about this building. Next you visit the War Remnants Museum, here you will see exhibits relating to the Vietnam War and the first Indochina War involving the French colonialists.

Other colonial structures included in the tour are Notre Dame Cathedral, built in the late 1880s by French colonists, it is one of the few remaining strongholds of Catholicism in the largely Buddhist Vietnam currently being renovated we can only look from the outside, and the General Post Office, constructed when Vietnam was part of French Indochina in the late 19th century

Finally, the tour ends at the famous Ben Thanh market, where you may practice your bargaining skills and pick up some souvenirs before being returned to your hotel.

**Cu Chi Tunnels Discovery Tour**

At either 8am or 1:30pm you will be met in the hotel lobby by your guide and a driver for the tour. Today you are off to the Cu Chi Tunnels which were pivotal to the Communist's victory over the Americans and the South Vietnamese Armies as they allowed the Viet Cong to control a large rural area around Saigon.

At its height, the tunnel system, parts of which were several levels deep, stretched over 200kms from Saigon to the Cambodian border. Today the remaining tunnels of this intricate network have been widened to accommodate visitors and has now become a major attraction giving a unique experience of what underground life in the American war must have been like and a deep appreciation of the courage and ingenuity of the Vietnamese people.

This is where guerilla warfare is exemplified and you will learn about the clever design of the tunnels and the strategic use of trap doors. Even with B-52 bombers dropping 30-ton loads of explosive, turning the jungle into a pockmarked moonscape, 30 thousand American troops failed to conquer the area! You will be offered the opportunity to crawl around a portion of the 121 km long, multiple-layered tunnel and learn how thousands of guerillas managed to stay underground for many days at a time, also their great technique to conceal smoke from their cooking. There're a lot more to enjoy and even a chance to fire with real weapons like AK47 for an additional fee. After the tour you will be returned to your hotel by private car.

There're a lot more to enjoy and even a chance to fire with real weapons like AK47 for an additional fee. After the tour is back to HCMC for a well-earned traditional Vietnamese lunch prior to starting the afternoon section of the tour.

**Excursion to My Tho (Mekong Delta)**

The Mekong Delta is also known as Vietnam's 'rice basket'-- a fertile area spreading nearly 50,000 sq km. Here the mighty Mekong river ends by splitting itself into nine major tributaries. The Vietnamese name these nine tributaries "Nine Dragons."

Pick-up will be from your hotel at 8am by your guide and driver for the day. You will then set off for the approximately 2hour drive to My Tho, a Mekong Delta town. On arrival in My Tho you will first visit Vinh Trang pagoda. Built in 1849 in My Phong village this beautiful structure features a mixture of Chinese, Vietnamese and Angkor (Cambodian) architectural styles and consists of five buildings, two ornamental yards and 178 pillars. Feel free to stroll in the gardens and check out the intricate carvings...

Following this you will board a boat for a cruise on the Mekong river, whilst sailing you will be passing natural creeks and quiet villages and watch rural people going to work. You will see an interesting fishermen's port and the traditional stilt houses. Keep your camera handy!

On arrival you will stop at Thoi Son islet in province of Tien Giang which has now become an ecotourism site. However, few people know that today's Thoi Son is thanks to the endless efforts of local people to develop the isolated isle into one of the region's go-to destinations. You will explore this region and its delights before returning to the cruise boat by small rowing boats through a short stretch of waterways. Lunch is in My Tho before you return to HCMC by private car.

#### Water Puppets Show & Dinner Cruise

Water puppetry is a tradition that dates back as far as the 11th century when it originated in the villages of the Red River Delta area of northern Vietnam. Today's Vietnamese water puppetry is a unique variation on the ancient Asian puppet tradition.

Pick-up at your hotel at 6pm for your private transfer to the Golden Dragon Water Puppet Theater.

You will get front row seats and the show will last approximately 45minutes and after which you will have a private transfer to Bach Dang Quay. You will then board a traditional Junk to enjoy a cruise on the river and a traditional set menu dinner on board. View HCMC from a different perspective and watch the lights as you sail by. After disembarkation you will be transferred back to your hotel to arrive about 9:30pm.

**Mekong Excursion & Cai Be Floating Market**

Pick up is from your hotel lobby where you will meet your guide and driver for the day before heading toward the Mekong, approximately 2 ½ - 3hours away. During the drive you can enjoy the green paddy fields stretching towards the horizon & watch locals going about their daily chores.

When you arrive at Cai Be, you'll board a motorized boat that takes you to the floating market and spend time here for some interaction with local residents that you'll see nowhere else in the world.

Next, your row boat will zigzag thru a maze of shadow canals to arrive at a great orchard where you can freely taste many famous tropical fruits of Vietnam and watch locals' daily chores.

Then we'll see how coconut candy, crispy rice cake and ceramic are made here . Lunch is at local garden house After this, we will ride bicycles and roam through the villages to check out several rural shops, or as an alternative you may simply relax in a hammock for a short rest.

Arriving at a marketplace we take a stroll to see how and what the poor rural people of Vietnam sell. You are encouraged to interact with the vendors and see how friendly and respectful they are.
