# **DANANG**

'Da Nang, Vietnam's third largest city is in central Vietnam and well known for its sandy beaches and history as a French colonial port. It's close proximity to Hue- 3 hours North and Hoi An- 30 minutes South make it a perfect stopping point to enjoy the central region. Exploring away from the main area of Danang will unearth buckets of colonial architecture, an ancient citadel, a huge street food scene packed full of dishes you'll not see anywhere else in Vietnam and a vibrant atmosphere.'

# **Danang Discovery**

You will be met at your hotel in Da Nang by your guide and driver for the morning. Firstly, you will visit Cham museum - The Museum's first building was constructed in 1915 and opened to the public in 1919 but many Cham sculptures collected in Da Nang, Quang Nam and elsewhere were brought to the site over the preceding twenty years. With their roots dating back as far as 192 AD, Vietnam's indigenous Cham people lived an Indian way of life in both culture and language. The Cham Museum in Danang is dedicated to this period and the Champa existence which began predominantly in the coastal areas of Vietnam. Housing the largest exhibition of Cham sculpture in the world, the museum displays almost 300 terracotta and stone works of art ranging from the 7th to the 15th centuries.





Next you go to the Son Tra Peninsula where one of the many sites is the famous 68-meter-high tall lady Buddha, the highest in Southeast Asia. The statue of the Goddess of Mercy looks down upon the sea and the port, protecting the local fishermen and giving them strength to fight the waves and winds. From here the view is really terrific; you can view the entire downtown Danang. Keep your camera handy as great picture opportunities are abound on a clear day.

Finally, you will go to Han market a significant landmark in Da Nang, having been in operation since the French occupancy in the 1940s. This local market is set within a two-storey building where you can find hundreds of stalls selling an array of local produce, handicrafts, T-shirts, and accessories. It's very much like a miniature version of Ben Tanh Market central market in Ho Chi Minh City, and even if you aren't necessarily looking to buy anything it still offers a fascinating glimpse into local life in Da Nang.

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# My Son Sanctuary

Known as the "Valley of Kings," My Son was designated as UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1999. The ruins are considered to be Champa's counterpart to the other grand cities of Southeast Asia's Indian-influenced civilizations with a cluster of deserted and partially ruined Hindu temples and towers that were constructed between the 4th and 14th centuries AD by kings of Champa Kingdom.

You will be met at your hotel by your guide and driver for the tour at either 7:30am or 12:30pm depending on your preference. From here you will drive approximately 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  hours to the site of My Son where, with the assistance of your guide who will point out and discuss the significance of areas and artifacts on the site you will discover the legendary complex of royal towers and temples. You will have the opportunity to watch a Cham musical performance before you transfer back to Danang or Hoi An.

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# My Son Sanctuary & Hoi An Town

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You will be met at your hotel by your guide and driver for the tour at 8am. From here you will drive approximately  $1 \frac{1}{2}$  hours to the site of My Son where, with the assistance of your guide who will point out and discuss the significance of areas and artifacts on the site you will discover the legendary complex of royal towers and temples. You will have the opportunity to watch a Cham musical performance before you transfer to Hoi An for a lovely traditional lunch at a local restaurant.

Hoi An is an exceptionally well-preserved example of the most important trading port in Southeast Asia of the period from the 15th until the 19th centuries. Its buildings and street patterns reflect the influences, both local and foreign, that harmoniously combine to produce a unique heritage site.

You will walk along the ancient streets to discover the Japanese Bridge: One of the most photographed bridges in Vietnam, Tian Hou Pagoda: a gorgeous 19th-century temple dedicated to the goddess





Thien Hau, Tan Ky old house: A well-preserved 18th-century merchant's house, visit some Hoi An handicraft workshops and finally enter the Museum of History-Culture, before returning Da Nang to enjoy your evening.

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# **HOI AN**

'The former port city's melting-pot history is reflected in its architecture, a mix of eras and styles from wooden Chinese shophouses and temples to colourful French colonial buildings, ornate Vietnamese tube houses and the iconic Japanese Covered Bridge with its pagoda. A slow stroll through town reveals its gems plus the warm-hearted and traditional welcome of its inhabitants. A place not to be missed for any visitor to Vietnam'

# The Ancient Capital Hue

Hue city is located in central Vietnam on the banks of the Perfume River and is a beautiful example of an ancient Vietnamese Capital City. Surrounding the city still exist many pagodas constructed more than 300 years ago, and hundreds of temples and pagodas built in the early century. Hue is a place where royal music is originated, and a home to traditional famous dishes and sophisticated handicraft. As a unique city Hue ancient capital was classified by the government as a 'very precious property' and on December 1993 was recognized as a World Cultural Heritage Site by UNESCO.

Collection from your hotel will be at 8am and the transfer to Hue will take approximately 3 hours. If the weather is clear you will go via Clouds Ridge Mountains to admire the stunning view, if not you will transfer via the mountain tunnel. On arrival at Hue you will enjoy a boat trip on Perfume river, to soak up some of the atmosphere of Hué and where you will sail to visit Thien Mu pagoda an icon of Vietnam. The 21m-high octagonal tower was





constructed under the reign of Emperor Thieu Tri in 1844 and each of its seven stories is dedicated to a Buddha that appeared in human form.

After a traditional lunch at local restaurant, it onwards to visit the Royal Palace, once the actual home of the emperor and his concubines within the Citadel.

Khai Dinh King's mausoleum: he was said to be the most unpopular King in Vietnam history, and indeed they had to raise taxes by 30% across Vietnam to pay for his mausoleum, however today it is the most popular and attractive sites in Hue.

You transfer back to your Danang or Hoi An hotel will be via the tunnel.

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# Tra Que Vegetable Village

Depart from your hotel, transfer to Hoi An at about 8am where you will take the two-wheel option and cycle to Tra Que village approximately 30 minutes away through rural scenery.

Tra Que is a charming little village on the edge of Hoi An, the village is named after the sweet-scented vegetables that spice up the everyday meals of the Pho Hoi people. On arrival you will take a short stroll around the vegetable garden and learn the history of the village.

Then it's time to get to work as you join the gardening activities by preparing the land, fertilizing it with seaweed, raking the ground, sowing, watering and picking vegetables

After a relaxing foot soak you can help to prepare lunch with a local family. Traditional Hoi An dishes like Cao Lau and Quang noodles on the menu and you will also enjoy a cooking class presented by your local host where you





will learn to prepare 'Tam Huu' spring rolls which were primarily made from Tra Que vegetables and a local pancake with meat (Banh xeo) which are typical central Vietnam dishes.

After enjoying the fruits of your labour at lunch you will get back to work as you learn how to harvest and wrap the vegetables.

After a satisfying and educational day, you bid farewell to your host family before riding back to your hotel.

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# Tra Nhieu Fishing village

This tour takes you to visit the bustling port town Tra Nhieu, originating in the in 16th - 17th century it still preserves many characteristics of a peaceful countryside location on Thu Bon river bank

You will be met at your hotel lobby and transferred to a central meeting point in Hoi An from where you will ride your bicycle to Thu Bon wharf on Bach Dang street where you will take a local ferry sailing 3km along Thu Bon River to Tra Nhieu fishing village. This is a peaceful, romantic area where typical features of Vietnamese villages are still maintained and you are encouraged to enjoy the beautiful and poetic scenery. In the village you can see the paths winding around local garden houses shaded by scented betel-nut trees and you will be given a brief introduction to the history and traditional handicrafts of the village such as: farming, fishing, poultry and livestock breeding, sleeping mat making.

Next you will be taken in a boat with the local fisherman to learn how to cast a net, catch fish, shrimp and crab. A well-earned lunch follows with special dishes at a local house.

Sadly, it will be time to bid farewell to the local fishermen and catch the boat back to the wharf, from where you will cycle back to your hotel.

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# Lantern Making

Experience a traditional handicraft and enjoy the reality of daily life for Hoi An local people.

One of the greatest pleasures of any visitor to Hoi An is strolling along the beautiful streets of the old town at night under the flickering lights of the many beautiful lanterns. These colorful lanterns are not only the symbol of Hoi An old town but also a part of the spirit of the Hoi An and on this tour you will go to a traditional Hoi An handicraft village to make one.

At either 8am or 2pm depending on your preference, your local guide will meet you at the hotel lobby and you will transfer to a central point from where you will take a bicycle ride to a lantern making workshop in Hoi An village.

Here you will get a brief introduction to the history, shape, and color of the lanterns and get to choose your favorite sample of lantern. Next learn step by step with an individual craftsman how to make your lantern, and you had better pay attention, as you get to keep this lantern as a souvenir. The opportunity to buy other lanterns is available nearby. On completion of your masterpiece you will cycle back to your hotel or to Hoi An for your transfer.

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# **Cham Island Excursion**

This is the ideal tour for those who enjoy snorkeling, swimming and relaxing on beautiful white beaches surrounded by crystal clear waters. Cham islands are 15km from Cua Dai. There are 7 islands altogether named according to their shape or characteristics, Lao (pear), Dai (long), La (leaf), Kho (dry), Tai (ear), Mo (tomb), Nom (East Wind). The climate is cool round the year, trees and animals as well as marine life and coral which is plentiful here. There are also scenic spots around the island, such as Suoi Tinh (Love stream), Suoi Ong (Sir's stream), Hon Chong (Piled up rocks), Hang Ba (Lady's cave).

At 8am your local tour guide will pick you at your hotel for the transfer to Hoi An where you will take a speed boat from Cua Dai harbour. On arrival at the island you can visit Au Thuyen where the local boats hide their boats during storms, walk along rice fields to visit the over-100-years-old temple of Hai Tang Pagoda and fishing village. You may transfer from Bac island for snorkeling, swimming and wonderful views of the coral before returning to swim, sunbath and enjoy lunch with fresh seafood.

At 2pm you will return to your hotel by speedboat and transfer.

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# **Cam Thanh Water Coconut Village**

During the Vietnam war Cam Thanh Village was the shelter for local people and soldiers, and nowadays this place is famous for providing the most delicious seafood products in the area.

By choosing this tour you will have a chance to learn traditional fishing techniques and how to paddle the unique Vietnamese bamboo basket boats whilst exploring the now tranquil coconut-palm flanked waterways of a past war. We provide an authentic social and cultural insight into the Vietnamese local way of life, but you will also have the opportunity to take part in some hands-on activities that are fun, safe and interesting to people of all ages.

You will be met at your hotel lobby at 8am/ 2pm and take walk to Bach Dang dock (Danang guest will be collected by private a/c vehicle for the transfer). From here it is a wooden boat transfer to Cam Thanh water coconut village. You will receive a briefing about the daily life of Vietnamese fishermen, their families and their community before you board on boat and enjoy cruising on the Cua Dai River. Join the local fisherman on the river as you try your hand at casting a net, learn how to paddle the Vietnamese unique bamboo basket boat and explore the now tranquil coconut-palm flanking the waterways. You will hear first-hand about the extreme conditions endured by soldiers of both sides in this area during the Vietnam War.

Lunch is a traditional fair at local family house in the village. Relax and enjoy your surroundings before you bid farewell to your hosts and transfer back the hotel.

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# Tra Que Vegetable Village & Cam Than Water Coconut Village

At 8:00am you transfer to Hoi An from your hotel if staying in Danang, then ride bicycles to Tra Que Village about 30 minutes away through rural scenery.

On arrival you will visit the vegetable village and see the daily activities of the local farmers. Then continue riding your bicycle along De Vong River to Hoi An Beach dock. Here you will board a boat to Cua Dai sand dune, to enjoy casting net show and learn how to cast net yourself by local fishermen. You will continue to Cam Thanh Water coconut village where after a brief introduction to the history of the area you board a basket boat to sail along the water coconut river. The local fishermen here will teach you how to catch crabs (02 passengers/ boat). Now it's time to put all you have learned to the test as you divide into small teams for basket boat racing and catching crabs, there is a small prize for the winners, so expect it to be fun and competitive.

Back on the boats you will enjoy the folk songs sung by local people there.

Before enjoying a well-earned lunch at local family house.

After lunch, a lesson in 'funny tools' from the locals made using water coconut leaves. Followed by a visit to a craftman's house in the village, where you will be shown more skills and local talent from the villages.

At 2.30pm wave farewell to your hosts and enjoy a private transfer back to your hotel.

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# **Bicycle Tour of Hoi An**

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# Handicraft Highlights of Hoi An

At either 8am or 2pm depending on your preference, if based in Danang you will enjoy a private transfer from your hotel to Hoi An and from a Hoi An base you will walk to Bach Dang dock from where you will board your boat for the river transfer to Thanh Ha Pottery Village. In the 16th and 17th century Thanh Ha was a thriving village and it was famous for earthenware that was sold in many provinces throughout Central Vietnam. It was Thanh Ha villagers who made the bricks, tiles and floor slabs for the old buildings in Hoi An and the surrounding areas. Nowadays many old buildings in Hoi An need restoring and the Thanh Ha villager are the only contractors that can provide standardized bricks, tiles and floor slabs exactly like the ones when the old port town prospered. In the village you can observe all the steps of making a pottery product such as vase, pot, kettle, cooking pot, interact with the residents and learn more about their history and daily life.

Onwards then to Kim Bong carpentry village, located in Cam Kim Hamlet. This village is very famous for its carpentry, as almost all Hoi An ancient architecture was produced by their ancestors' talented hands at a time when Hoi An flourished as a major sea port. Kim Bong carpenters' techniques are perfect and their masterpieces admired by everyone. Today, many Kim Bong carpenters still keep their old career & traditions however, there have also been many among them who have shifted to ship building and restoring historical monument or relics. Here you will venture by two wheels as you cycle through the village whilst you are taught its history and have the





opportunity to see the craftsmen at work, go to visit the ship-building yards and see the handicrafts and sculptures before returning to Bach Dang dock by boat where you will either transfer by car to Danang or walk back to your Hoi An hotel.

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# My Son Sanctuary & Kim Bong Carpentry village

Known as the "Valley of Kings," My Son was designated as UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1999. The ruins are considered to be Champa's counterpart to the other grand cities of Southeast Asia's Indian-influenced civilizations with a cluster of deserted and partially ruined Hindu temples and towers that were constructed between the 4th and 14th centuries AD by kings of Champa Kingdom.

You will be met at your hotel by your guide and driver for the tour at 7:30-8 am and from here you will drive approximately  $1\frac{1}{2}$  hours to the site of My Son where, with the assistance of your guide who will point out and discuss the significance of areas and artifacts on the site you will discover the legendary complex of royal towers and temples. You will have the opportunity to watch a Cham musical performance before you board your transfer back Hoi An by private car to board the boat on Thu Bon River for the trip to Kim Bong.

Kim Bong Carpentry Village has been established since the 16th century, the village which originated in the north of Vietnam, has had its artisans work on furniture and houses across the country, from prominent buildings in Hanoi to Hue citadel and royal tombs or most of the architectural projects in Hoi An's heyday. Enjoy a leisurely bicycle ride in the village as you learn why the style of Kim Bong Carpentry is said to be the excellent combination of Cham kingdom, China, Japanese... and of course the talented hands of Vietnamese craftsmen. You will return from the village by boat.
