Then continue passed The Opera House to the wonderful Hoan Kiem Lake and walk across the famous red wooden bridge to visit Ngoc Son Temple set on a tiny island. This is the perfect opportunity for a memorable photograph before a traditional Vietnamese lunch of Pho (pronounced FUR!) a noodle meat/vegetarian broth.

We start the afternoon trip by a visit to the National Museum of Vietnam History tracing the history of Vietnamese people from the earliest times to the present day. It’s a wonderful museum and enhanced by a private guide to give further details on the exhibits.

Then stop around Ham Tu Quan for an enjoyable one-hour cyclo ride through the 36 streets of the Old Quarter. Although the old section of Hanoi is often called the "36 Old Streets," there are more than 36 actual streets. Some

researchers believe that the number 36 came from the 15th century when there might have been 36 guild locations, which were workshop areas, not streets.

After a little light shopping & possibly an 'Egg Coffee' (ask your guide!), you will then be transferred back to your hotel to enjoy the evening.

**Duong Lam Ancient Village**

Duong Lam village in Son Tay Town (some 60km to the west of Hanoi Capital) is the first ancient village recognized as a national relic by the Ministry of Culture and Information.

The ancient village has a history of about 1,200 years with many houses dating back up to 400 years. One special thing about the village is that most of the buildings here are made of laterite and mud, two materials that are abundant in the area. Laterite is used on house walls, gates, wells, temple walls, and so forth.

Apart from its historical and tourism values, Duong Lam ancient village is an important place for scientists to study resident communities in ancient agriculture. The village gate, banyan, well, communal house are important factors in classifying Duong Lam ancient village.

Pick-up at your hotel at 8am and transfer to Duong Lam ancient village. Arrive in Duong Lam Town via the "Mia" Pagoda - is built in 15th century, to admire the 287 statues of all sizes and the famous sculptures such as the statue of Buddha in the Himalayas and the statues of the Eight Vajra Deities. Once in the village you may take a stroll to visit market around the ancient village to see architectural delights such as the communal House.

Pay a visit to the Temples of two of Vietnam's kings, Phung Hung (761-802) and Ngo Quyen (896-944) who were born in Duong Lam, giving the village its prestige. Both men led resistance wars against northern invasion and

after winning national independence, were crowned kings. After their deaths, the local people built temples in their honour.

Lunch at local restaurant is a traditional fair (no drinks).

The sightseeing continues to visit Mong Phu temple in Mong Phu hamlet. Then take a trip to explore special ancient village gate there. The original village entrance gate remains intact, dedicated to national heroes. Continue to visit some of the 400+ year old houses and enjoy some interactions with the residents.

Your return to your Hanoi hotel is by private transfer.

**Hoa Lu Temples & Tam Coc**

The ancient capital Hoa Lu is a destination which will take you back to the medieval eras in Vietnams past. This region called Ninh Binh is known for its landscape and outstanding natural beauty, with huge limestone rocks emerging from the ground surrounded by paddy fields. This is why Hoa Lu & Tam Coc are considered as Halong bay on land, and whose splendour is often said to surpass that of Halong bay.

At 8:00am you will be picked up at your hotel by your guide and driver and depart for Hoa Lu a, 2hour drive through picturesque countryside.

Upon arrival visit the historic capital of Vietnam, Hoa Lu and the famous ancient temples of Le and the Dinh Dynasties, the two heroes who built this citadel in the 10th century. The architecture here is unique and well worth taking your time admiring.

From here it’s onwards to Tam Coc for a traditional hearty lunch at around 12:30.

After lunch, embark for a sampan boat trip to visit Tam Coc to see the beauty of the geological formations. With Halong bay type views of majestic limestone cliffs and mysterious caves, as well as countryside landscape like peaceful streams, rice paddies and deserted green fields, Tam Coc has earned the reputation of being called ‘Halong on Land.

After disembarking it is the two-wheel option, as you cycle for an hour, about 5km on quiet roads through villages, rice fields, rivers and rocky outcrops in Tam Coc - Bich Dong. A chance to admire nature at a different pace and meet the locals in their environment.

Private transfer back to Hanoi with a drop off at your hotel at around 5:30pm

**Perfume Pagoda Boat Trip**

The Perfume Pagoda is one of the most important religious sites in Buddhist Vietnam. It is a vast complex of Buddhist temples and shrines built into the limestone Huong Tich mountains. Every spring, after the Lunar New Year, thousands of Vietnamese pilgrims come here to pray for the health and prosperity they need all year through. You will glide along scenic waterways and walk up mountain paths to visit pagodas and temples.

At 8:00am your guide and driver will pick you up at your hotel in Hanoi and depart for a 2hour scenic road trip through the countryside.

On arrival you will embark on a 1 ½ hour row-boat trip on the Yen Vy waterways to admire the charming landscapes on the way to Thien Tru harbor. A walk up steep paths is rewarded with a visit to the main cave Huong Tich, at the top of the mountain. You will descend via the cable car option, enjoying a splendid panoramic view of the valley.

Once back at the bottom of the mountain you can enjoy a well-earned lunch at a local restaurant.

After lunch, its onward to visit the Heavens Kitchen pagoda (Thien Tru Pagoda) to learn about Buddhist ancient architecture from Le’s Dynasty from which you will return by row-boat.

You will then transfer back to Hanoi arriving at your hotel at approximately 6pm.
